This raises the possibility that some of the increase in QAnon awareness is attributable to re-asking the same people. [Several studies](#) have found significant effects from this measurement issue (known as panel conditioning) on knowledge questions. While this study provides strong support for a real increase in Americans' awareness of QAnon, these data offer only a rough approximation for the exact size of that increase due to this limitation. Studies have found little to no conditioning effects on survey questions unrelated to knowledge about particular topics.
