This report contains valuable statistics regarding number of public & private Health Institutions; Hospitals, Dispensaries, T.B Clinics, Rural Health Centres (R.H.Cs.), Basic Health Units (B.H.U.s.), Sub Health Centres (S.H.Cs.), Maternity & Child Health Centres (M.H.Cs.), and Trauma Centres, along with their bed strength, in-door & outdoor patients treated in these Health Institutions, Registered Medical & Para-Medical Personnel at the Tehsil, District, and Divisional levels. . The current edition has been further improved by adding new indicators; Dengue Patients (affected, treated, and recovered), Registered Births and Deaths, Registered Private Hospitals (Cat-I & II) from 01-01-2023 to 31-12-2023, Total Registered Private Hospitals (Cat-I & II) up to 31-12-2023, and Registered Private Healthcare Establishments (Cat-III).

This publication is composed on the basis of data received from Directorate General Health Services, Punjab, Chief Executive Officers (C.E.O's) Health, Inspector General (I.G.) All information is provided at Tehsils/ Districts and Divisional Levels.

Coverage

“**Punjab Health Statistics 2024**” covers information regarding Hospitals, Dispensaries, T.B. Clinics, Rural Health Centers (RHCs), Basic Health Units (BHUs), Sub-Health Centers (SHC) and Maternity & Child Health Centers (MCH) located in Punjab under administration of Health Department, Home Department, Auqaf Department, Pakistan Railways, WAPDA, Punjab Employees' Social Security Institution (PESSI), and Private HealthCare Establishments located in Punjab province.

Note: - Health Institutions belonging to the Federal government and Defense Services are not being covered.

Data Collection System

i) Health Department

Health Institutions belonging to the Health Department in the province are required to keep a record of all the out-door and in-door treated patients in an “**Abstract Register**”. From the information recorded in the “Abstract Register” and other relevant registers, all types of Health Institutions are required to supply annual statistical returns to the District Health Offices.

ii) Other Departments/Organizations

Pakistan Railways, Home Department, WAPDA, Auqaf Department Punjab Employees' Social Security Institutions (PESSI) and Punjab Healthcare commission collect the annual Statistics from their health institutions and compile the data by Tehsil, District, Divisional, and Provincial levels at their Head Offices.

Important Definitions

Health Institution:

A health institution is defined as an institution that provides health services i.e. curative and preventive to all/specific class of the public as out-door/ in-door patients.

This publication covers about 4920 institutions delivering heavily subsidized healthcare to the public. These facilities are broadly divided into the following groups (i) Basic Health Units (BHUs), (ii) Sub Health Centers (SHC), (iii) Rural Health Centers (RHCs), (iv) Maternal and Child Health Centers (MCH), (v) Tuberculosis Centers (TB), (vi) Dispensary (vii) Hospitals.

Sub Health Center (S.H.Cs):

These facilities are staffed with a physician, one Lady Health Visitor, and a midwife. It provides primary health care services to the catchment areas where there are no basic health units. 137 SHCs are covered by this publication.

Basic Health Unit (B.H.U.s):

It is the first level of health care considered to be essential to maintain adequate health and protection from disease. Typically, each Union Council has a BHU which has 2 beds, but in some cases there are two facilities per union council and serves a catchment population of about 10,000 to 25,000.

This publication covers 2583 BHUs spread across the length and breadth of the province.

Rural Health Centers (RHCs):

BHUs are almost all over the place in rural areas, they have limited usefulness for patients seeking slightly advanced but not specialized care. To serve such patients, the health system has established a tier of facilities known as RHCs. The RHCs are better equipped than BHUs to manage minor emergencies and surgeries. Typically, the RHC has 15-20 beds inpatient facility and each serves a catchment population of about 100,000. This is envisaged as a health facility that is open 24/7.

This publication covers about 359 RHCs across the province.

Maternal and Child Health Centers (MCHs):

These facilities provide maternal, neonatal and child health services including reproductive health and family planning and are often located in urban and large rural areas. Maternal and child health centers are managed by Lady Health Visitors and assisted by a facility-based trained traditional birth attendant. This publication covers 268 MCHs.

Important Definitions

Tuberculosis Centers (TBs):

These centers detect and manage tuberculosis (TB) patients. This Publication covers 36 T.B Clinics across the Punjab.

Dispensaries:

A dispensary is an institution having less than ten beds. This publication covers about 1188 dispensaries outlets in the province.

Hospital:

Hospital is an institution having ten or more than ten beds.

The Hospitals are broadly divided into three types: (i) Tehsil Headquarter (THQ), Hospitals, (ii) District Headquarter (DHQ) Hospitals (iii) Teaching Hospitals.

Tehsil Headquarter Hospitals:

These hospitals serve a catchment population of about 0.5 - 1 million, providing a range of preventive, clinical and rehabilitative services. Presently Tehsil Headquarters have 40 - 60 beds inpatient facility and a range of outpatient services.

District Headquarter Hospitals:

These hospitals cover a catchment population of 1 - 3 million, having 125 - 250 beds capacity. The district headquarters hospital provides promotive, preventive, curative, advanced diagnostic and inpatient specialized services.

Teaching Hospitals:

These hospitals deal with the most advanced healthcare requirements and prepare doctors and paramedical staff for future needs. These hospitals are located in urban centers, exclusively in all divisional headquarters.

There are 59 teaching hospitals in the province, of which 21 are in Lahore.

Trauma Centers:

A trauma center is a hospital equipped and staffed to provide care for patients suffering from major traumatic injuries such as falls, motor vehicle collisions, or gunshot wounds. A trauma center may also refer to an emergency department (also known as a "casualty department" or "accident and emergency") without the presence of specialized services to care for victims of major trauma.

This publication covers about 10 trauma centers outlets in the province.

Important Definitions

Punjab Healthcare Commission

The Punjab Healthcare Commission, established under the Punjab Healthcare Commission Act, 2010 (PHC Act, 2010), is an independent regulatory body, mandated to improve the quality, safety, and efficiency of healthcare service delivery in all Public and Private Healthcare Establishments (HCEs) in the province of Punjab and to ban quackery in all its forms and manifestations. The Commission has a dual role, that of a regulator and an adjudicator of the rights and responsibilities of the patients, Healthcare Service Providers, and HCEs. In this connection, the PHC registers the Healthcare Service Providers and issues licenses to their HCEs on the basis of compliance with the standards prescribed by the PHC.

Categories of the Healthcare Establishments.

Category-I

Indoor facilities having 50 or more beds.

Category-II

Indoor facilities having less than 50 beds further divided in sub-categories

- II-A 31 to 49 beds
- II B 16 to 30 beds
- II C Up to 15 beds

Category-III

Hakeem Matab, Homoeopathic Clinic.

MCHC/ CMWs/ Nursing/ Maternity Home, Family Physicians/ Single Man (GPs) Clinic, Single Specialty Clinic, Poly Clinic, Dental Clinic (Single Chair / Multiple Chairs).

Pathology Lab including Static Labs, Main Lab having Collection Centres, Pathology Lab + Imaging Centre, Collection Centre, X - Ray/ Imaging Centre, Pathology Lab/ Imaging centre having CT Scan/ MRI/ Angio/ other advanced facilities, Cosmetic Surgery/ Hair Transplant/ Liposuction Centres.

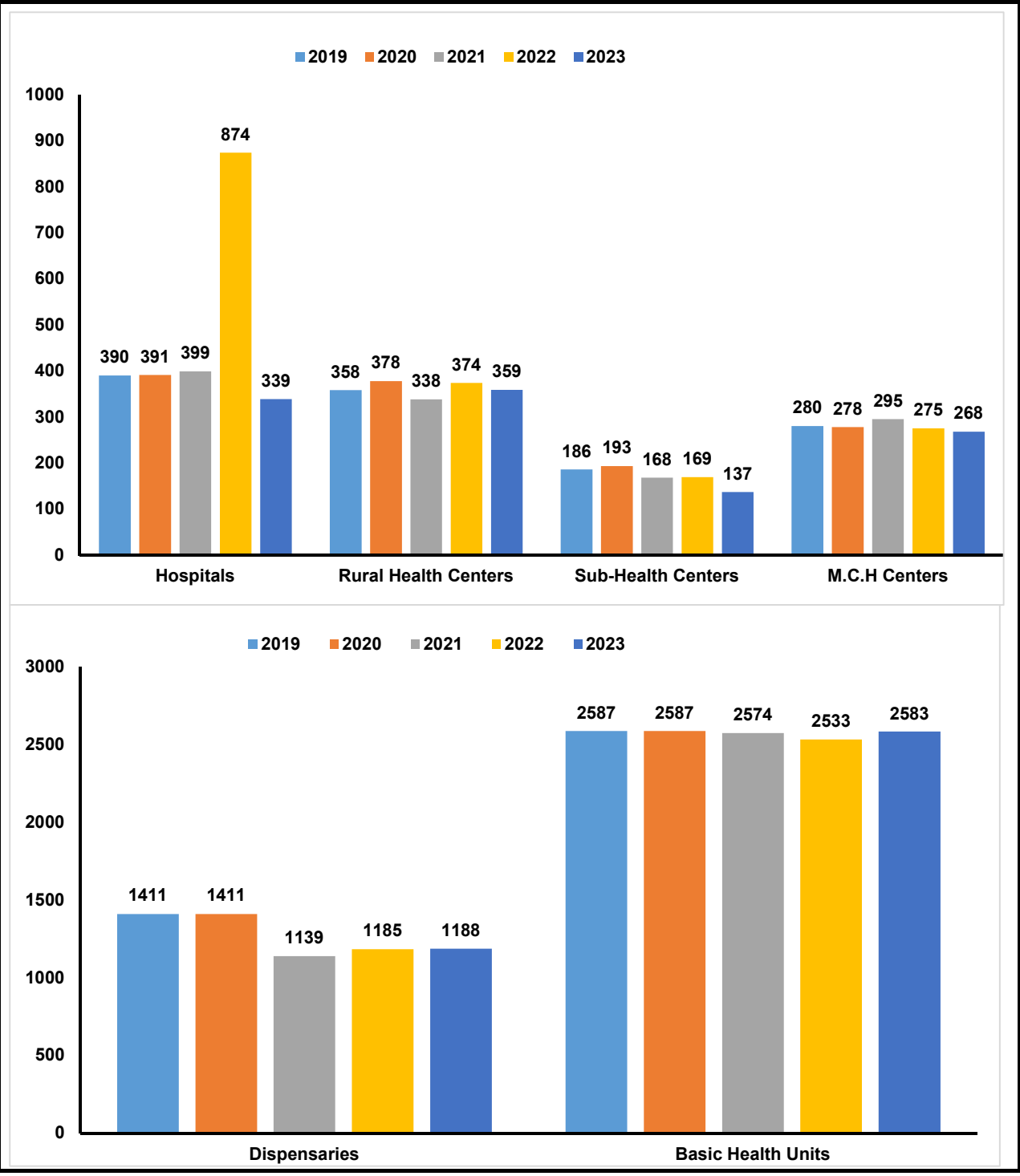

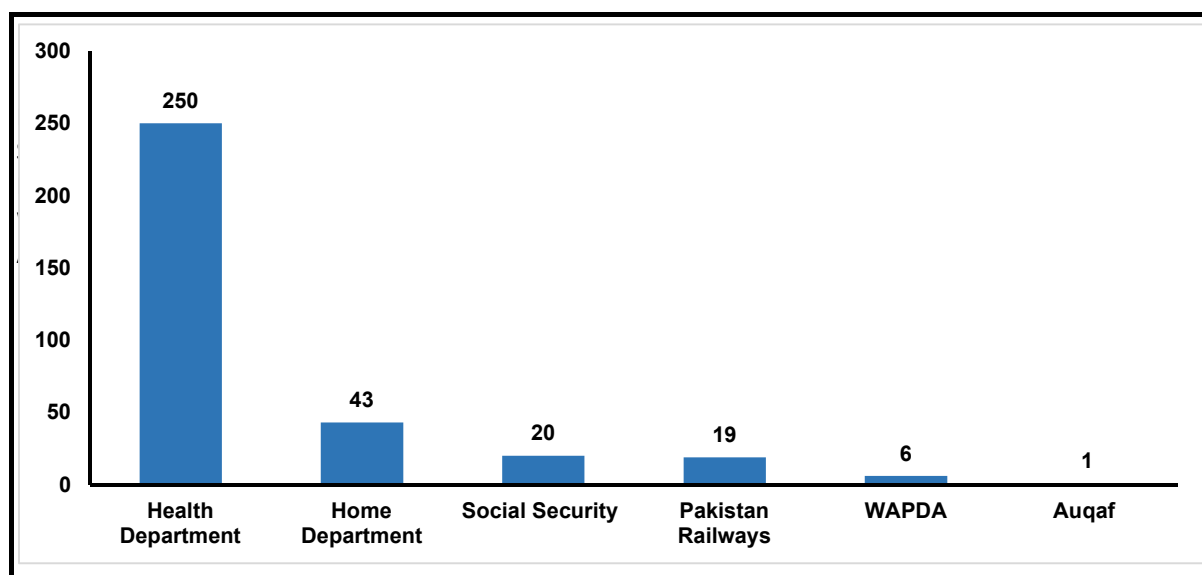

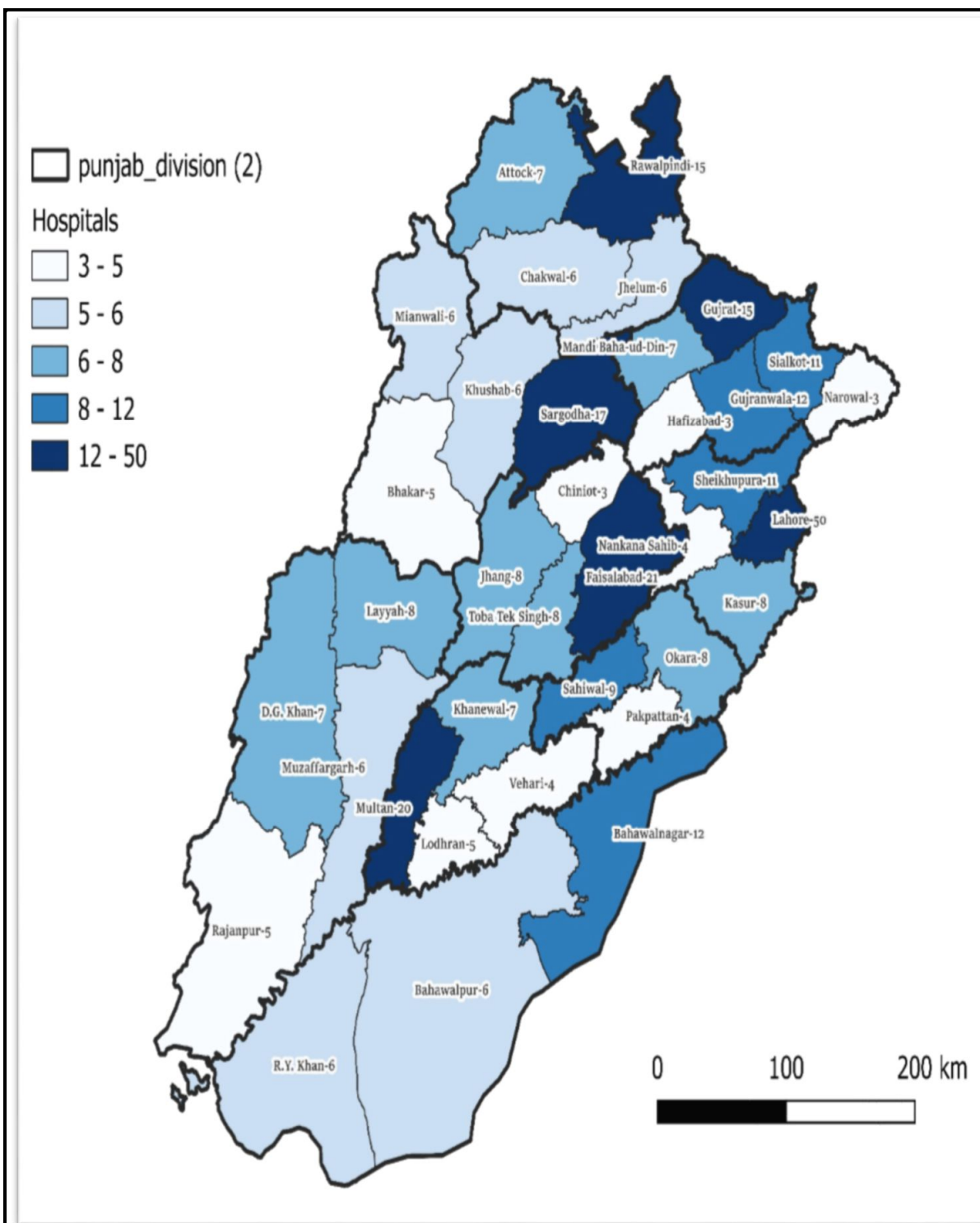

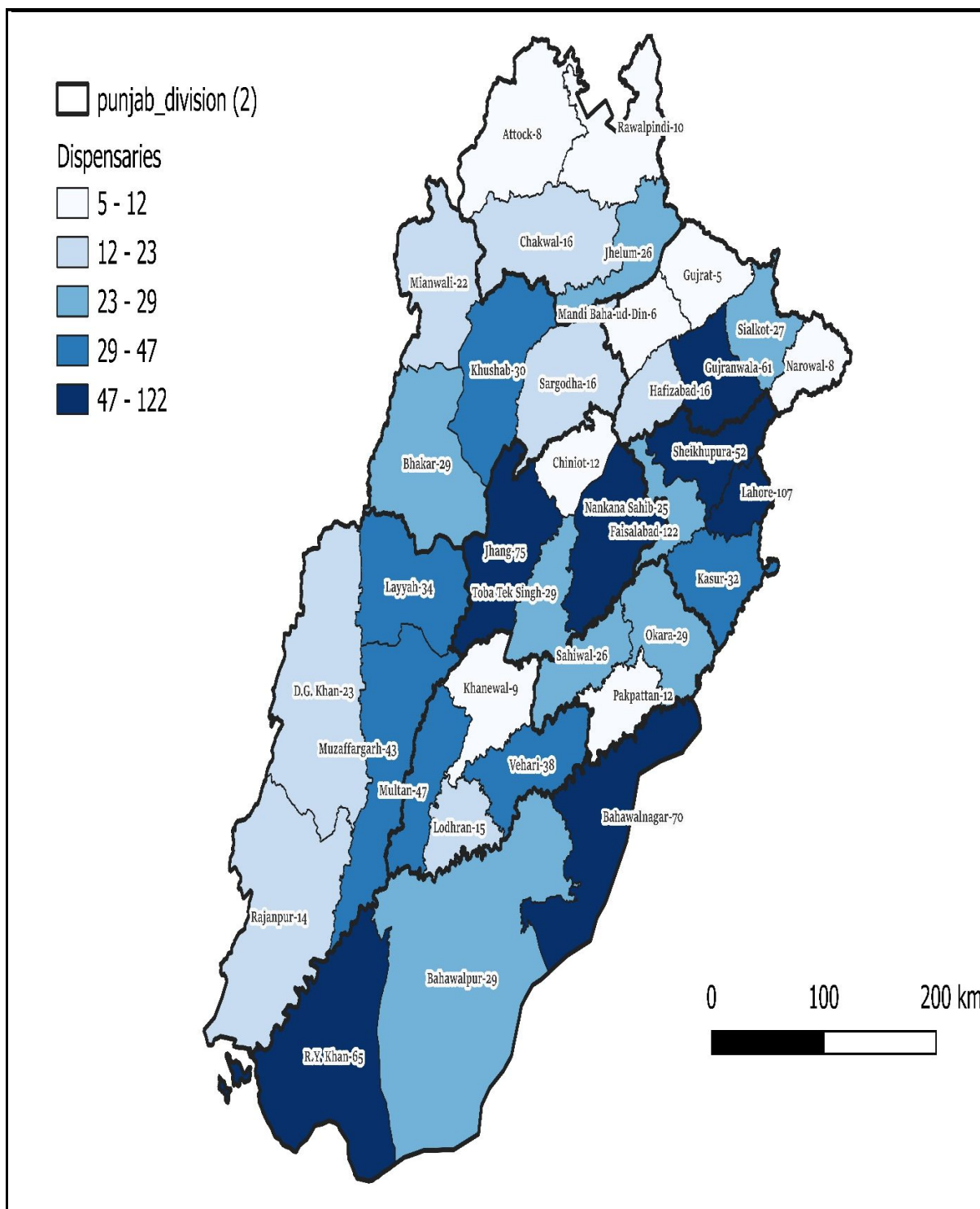

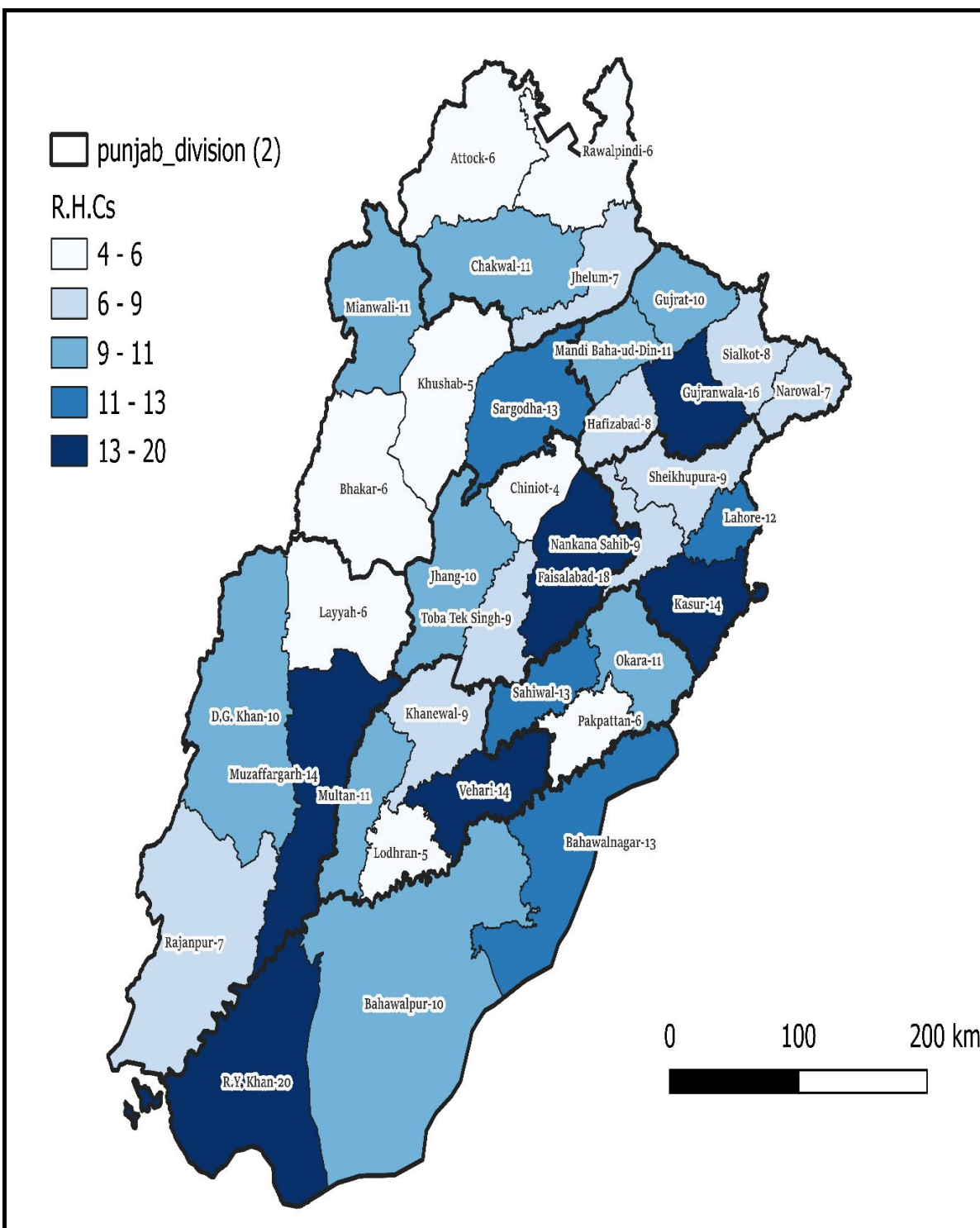
Figure 4: Total Number of Dispensaries by District, The Punjab: Upto 31-12-2023

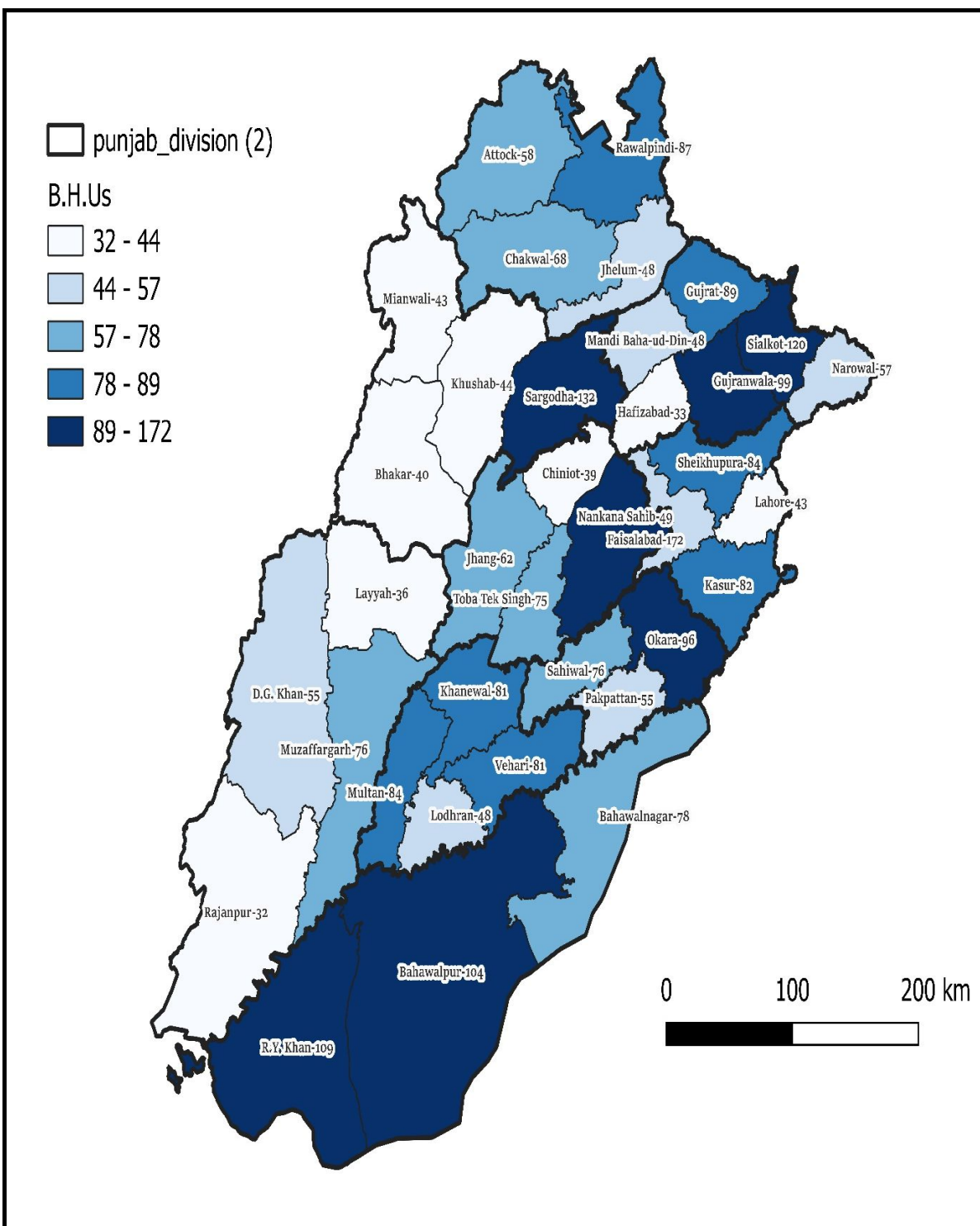
Figure 5: Total Number of R.H.Cs by District, The Punjab: As on 31-12-2023

Figure 7: Population Per Hospital by Division, The Punjab: Upto 31-12-2023

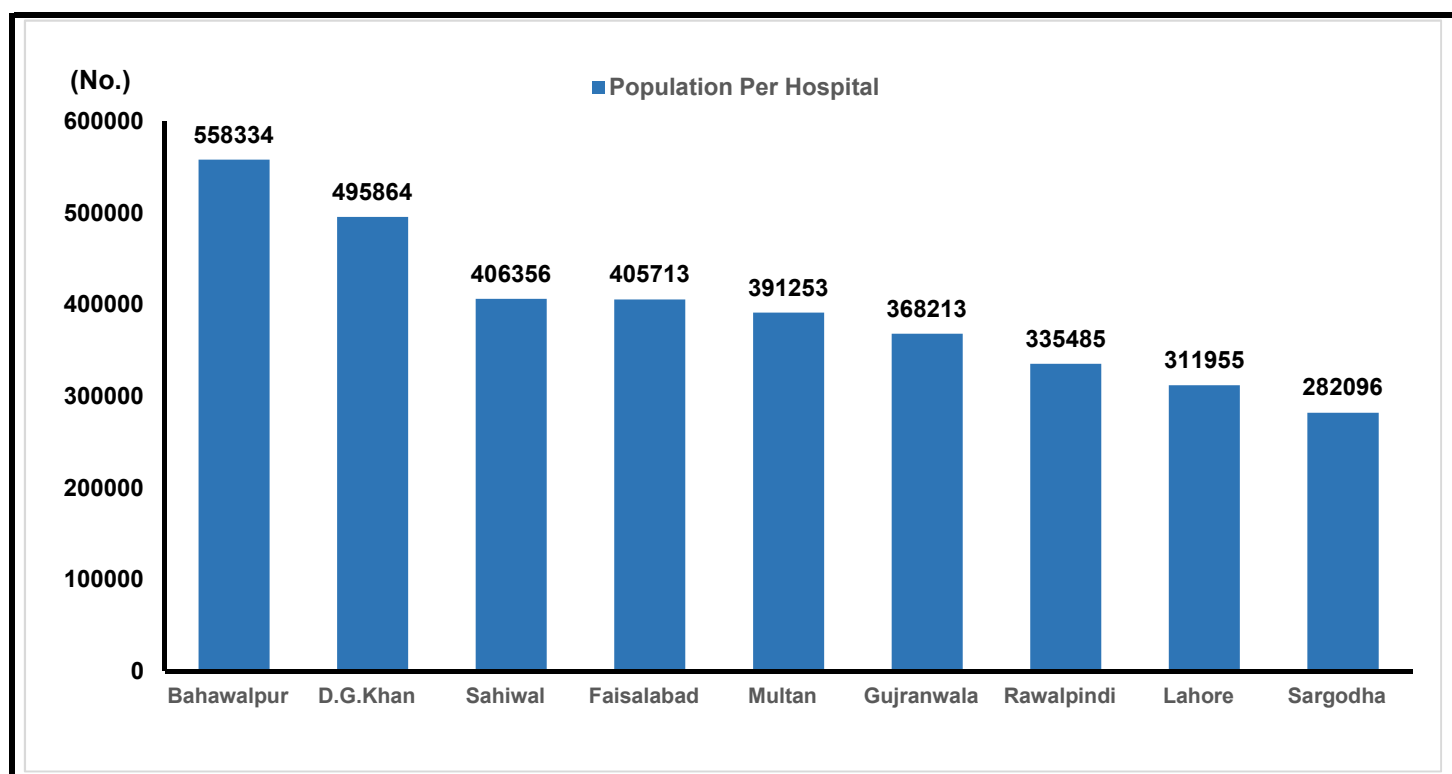
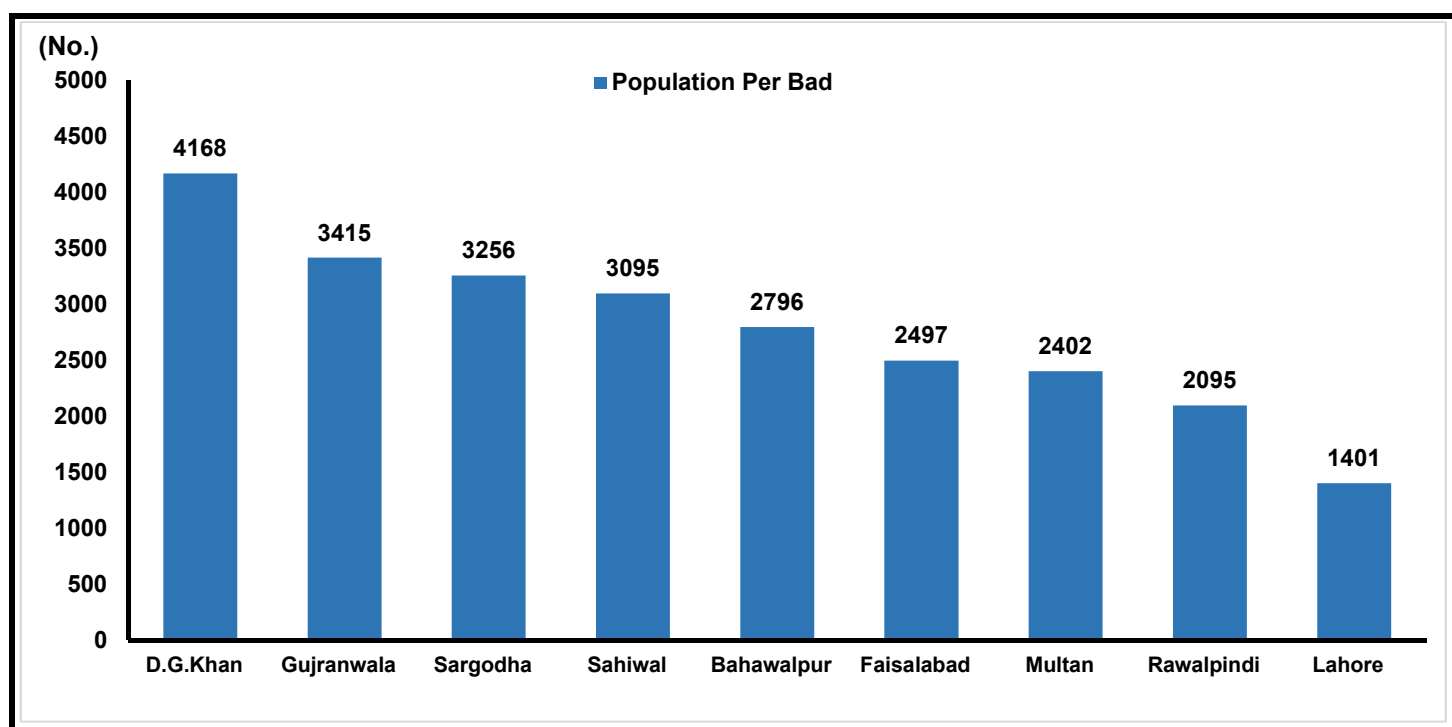


Figure 8: Population Per Bed of the Hospitals by Division, The Punjab: Uoto 31-12-2023

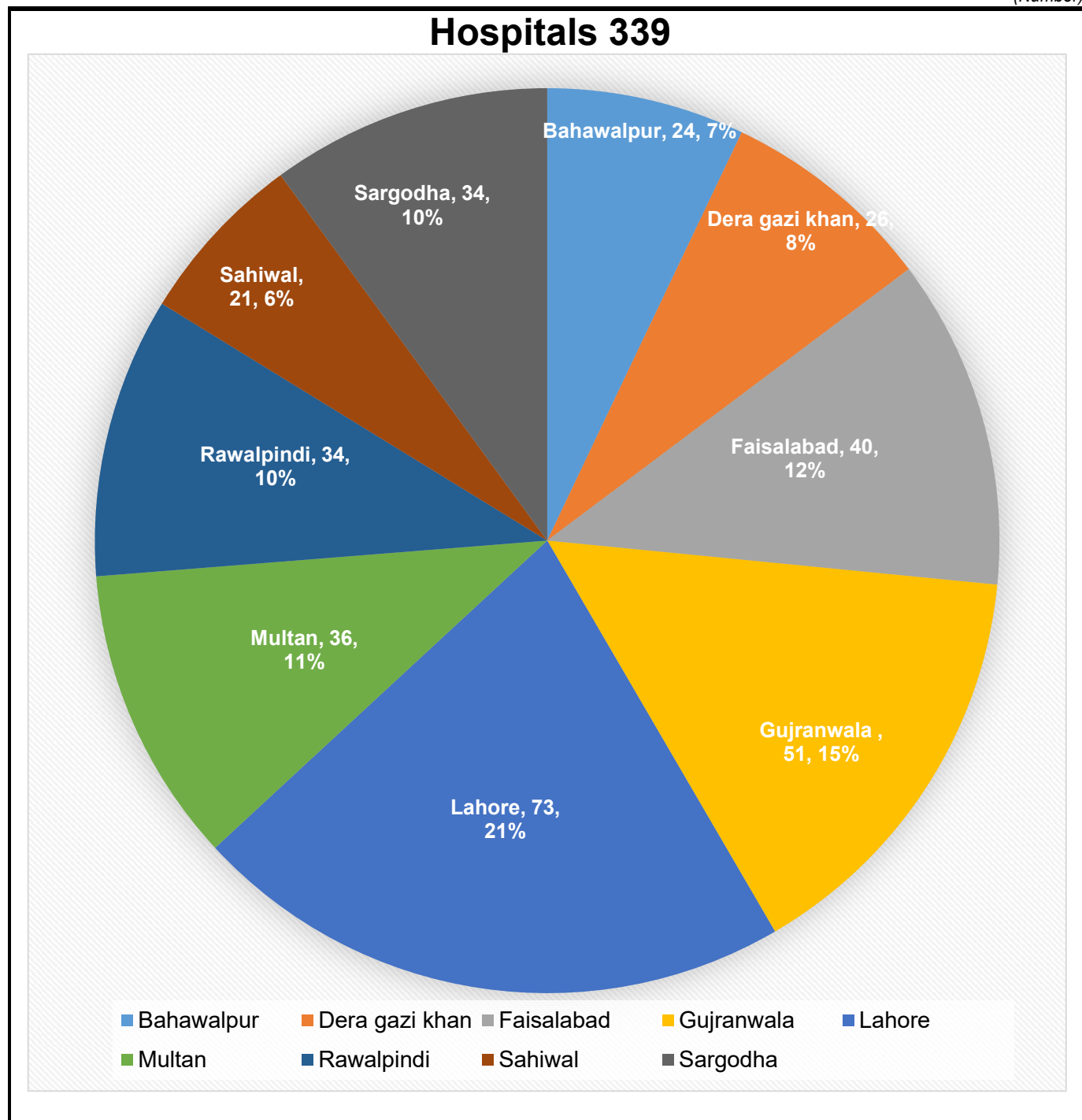

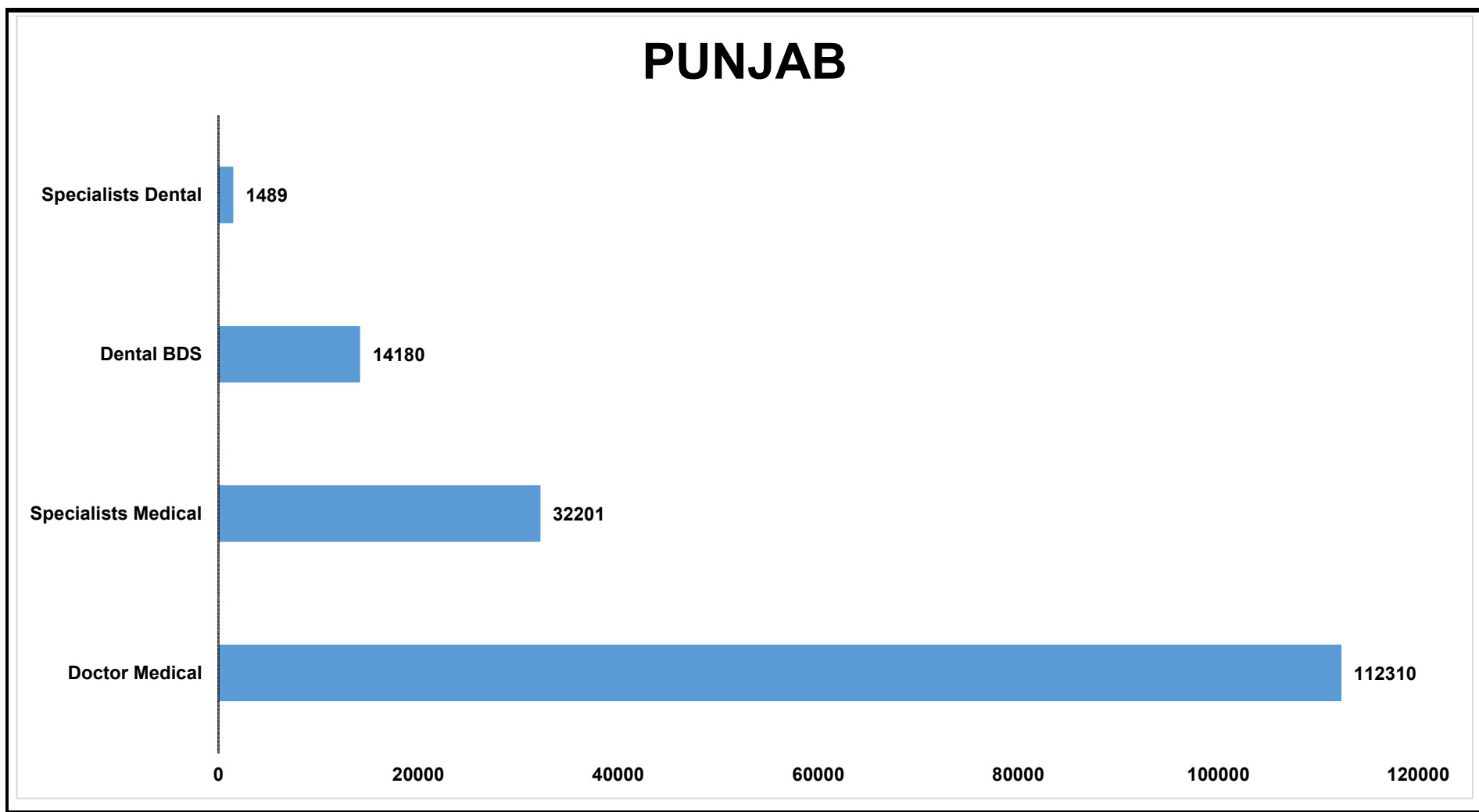

Figure 10: Registered Medical Personnel in Punjab: Upto 31-12-2023

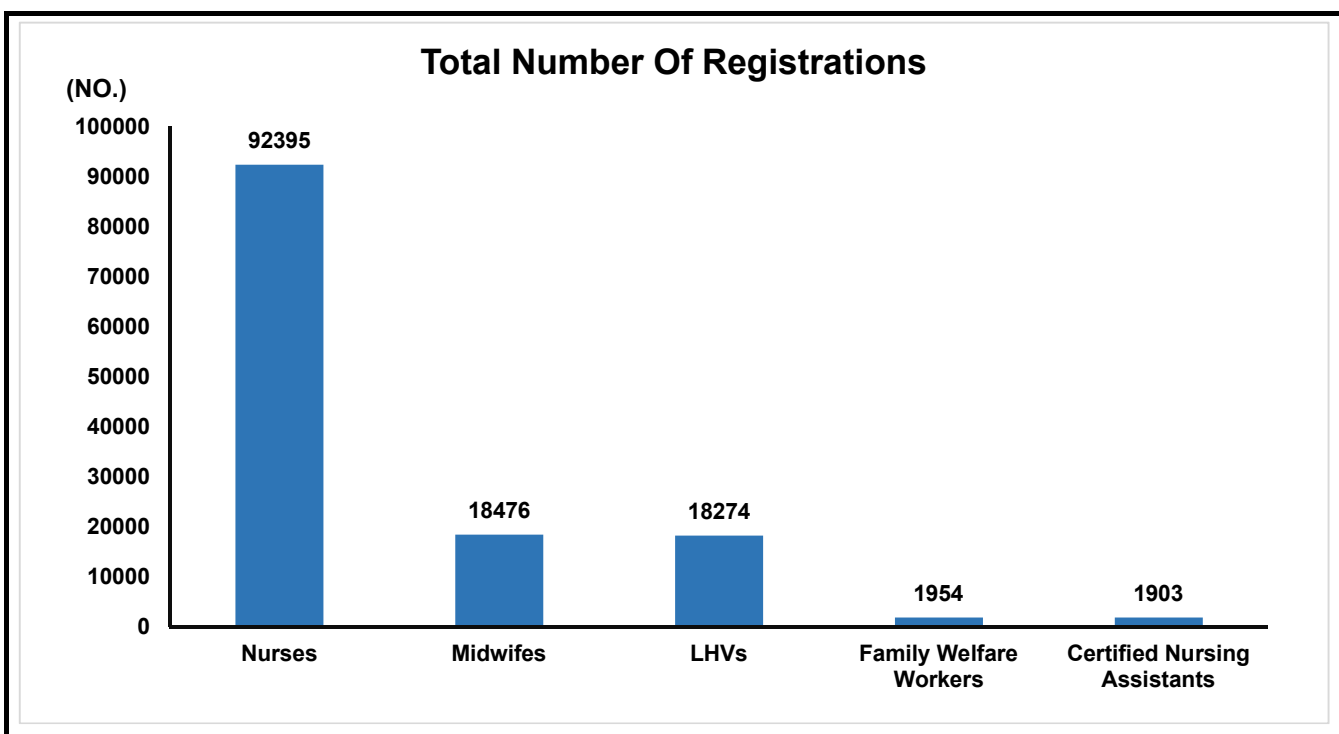

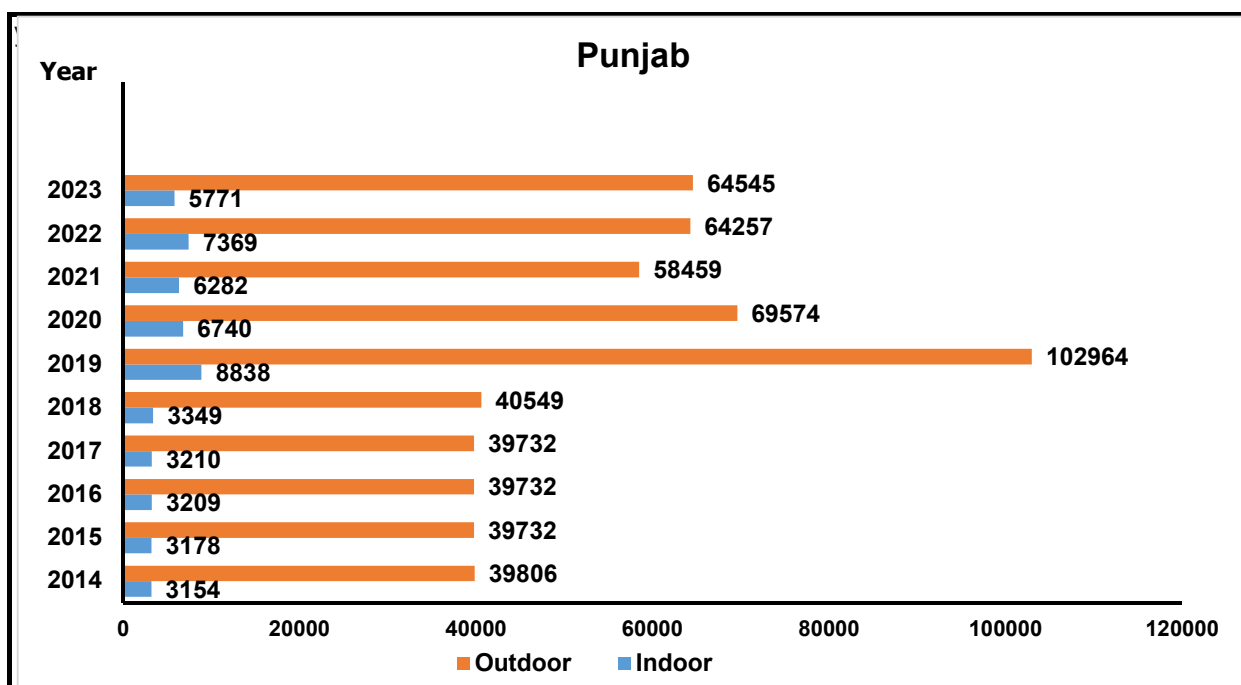

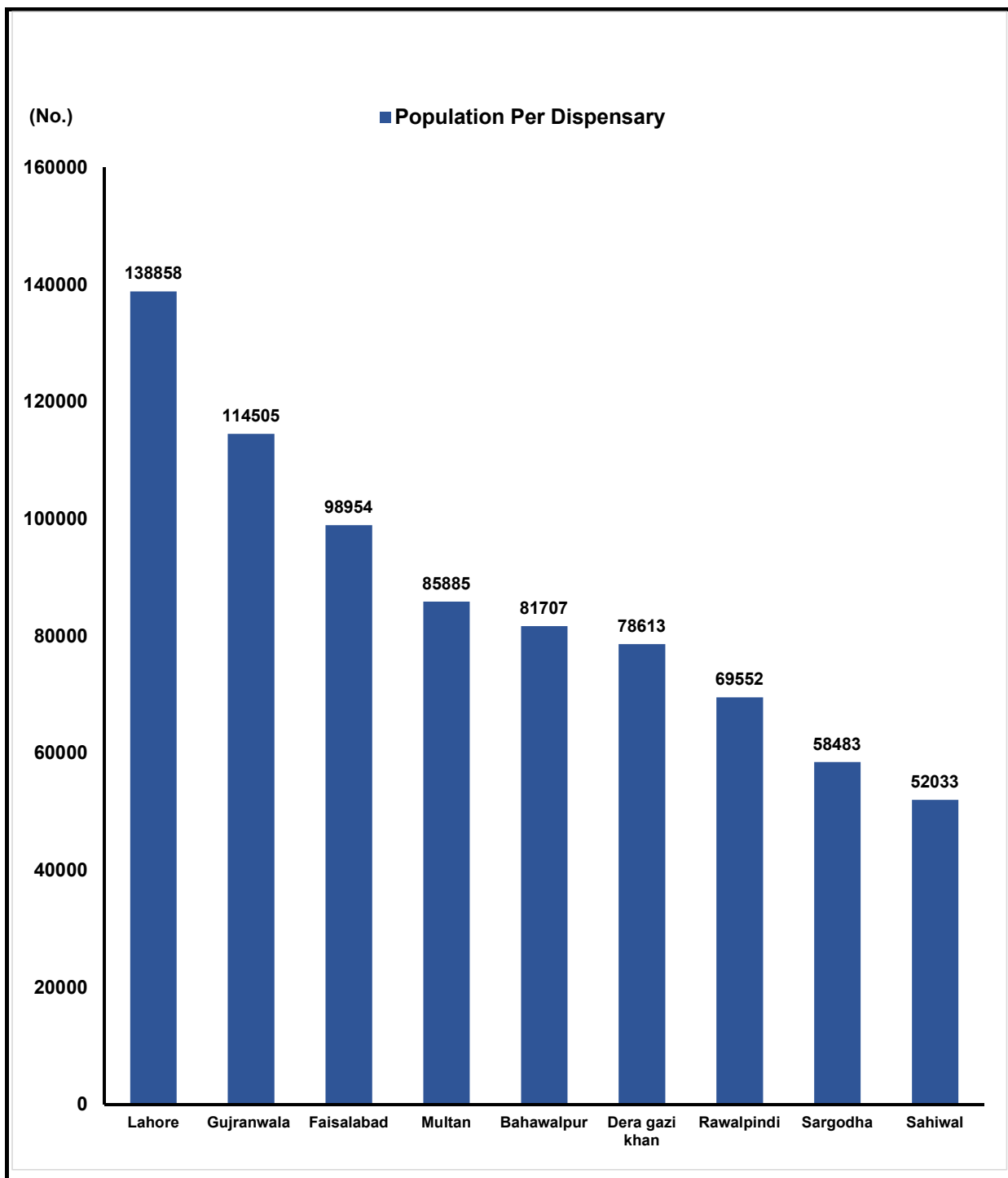

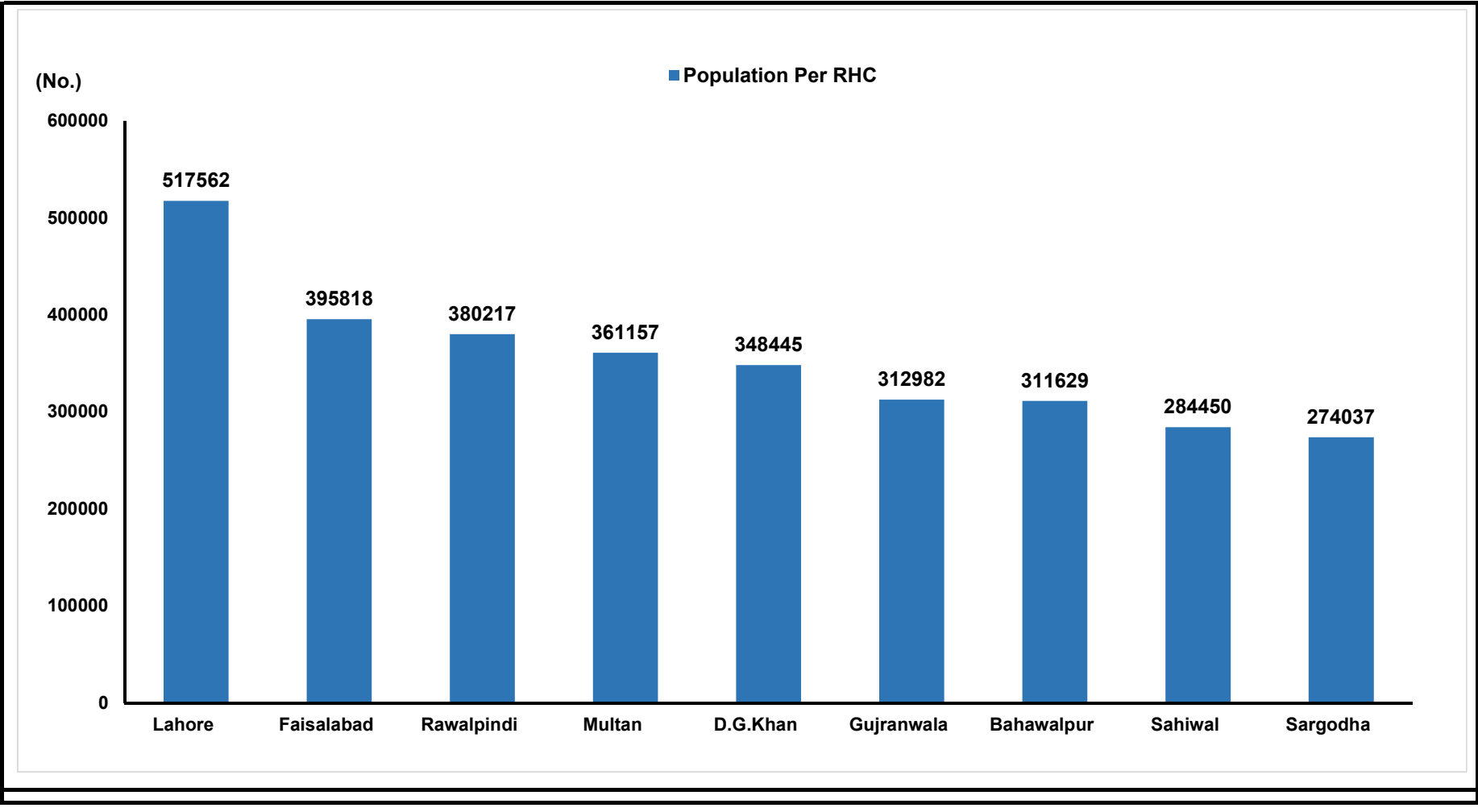

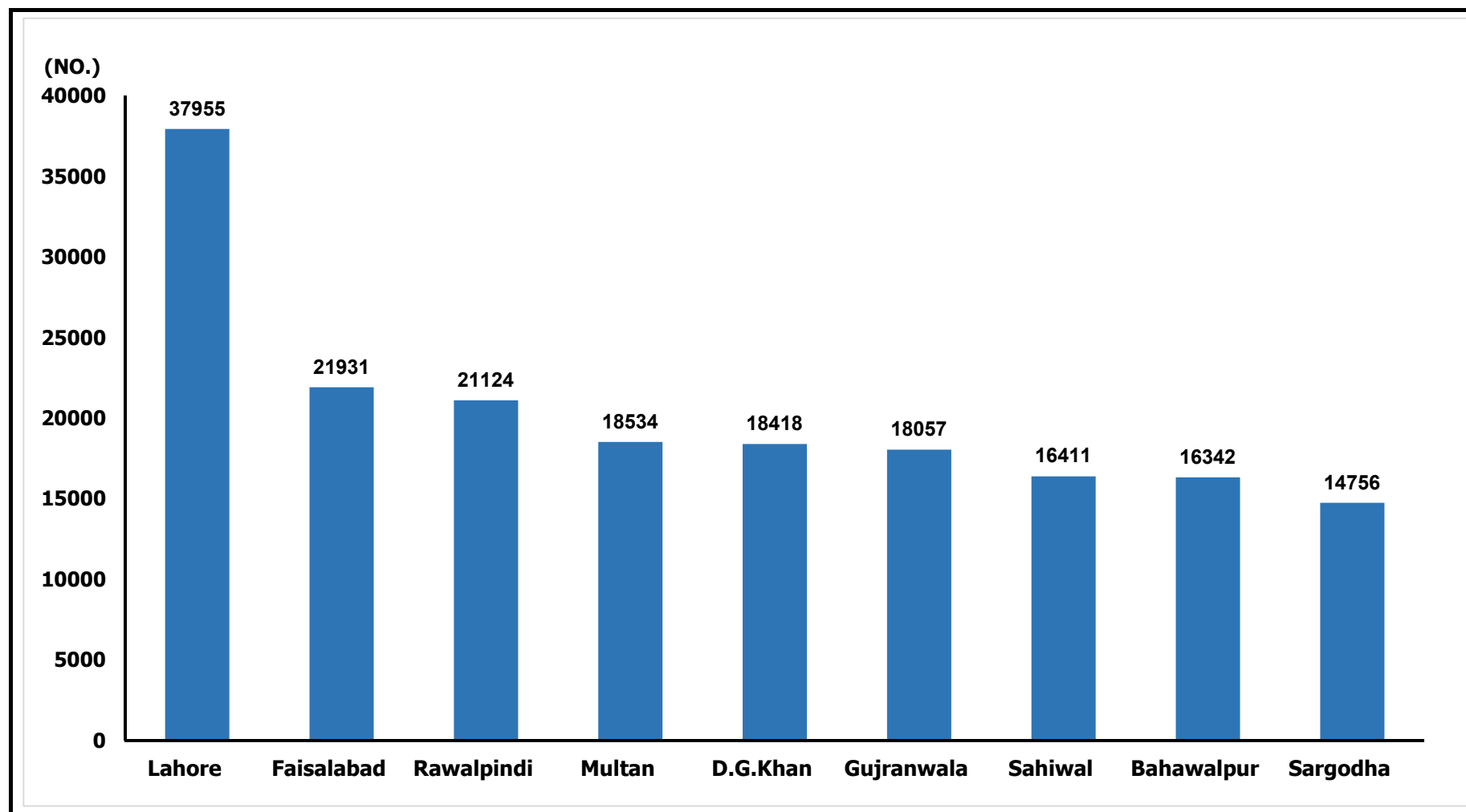

Figure 16: Population Per B.H.U by Division, The Punjab: Upto 31-12-2023

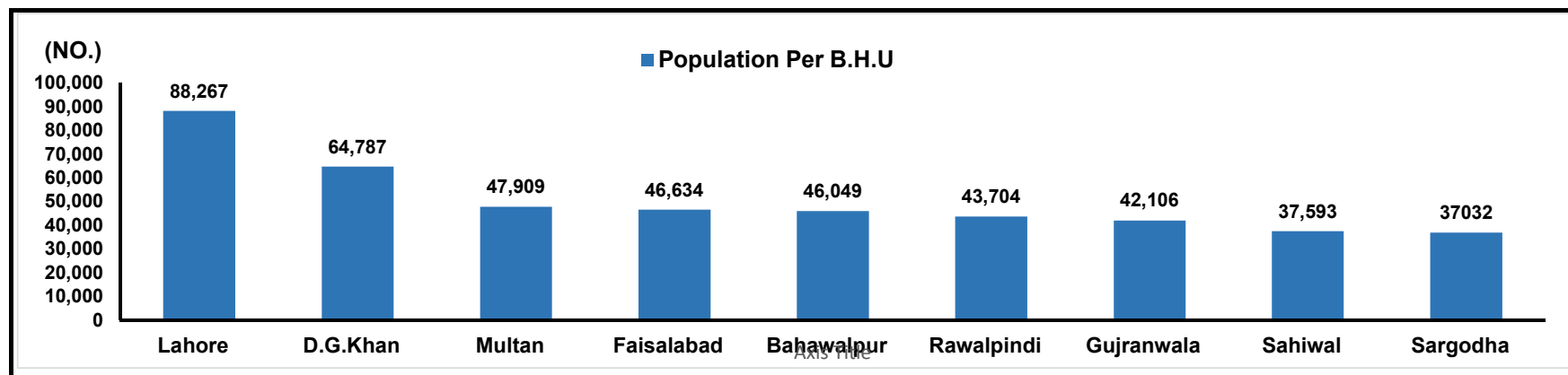
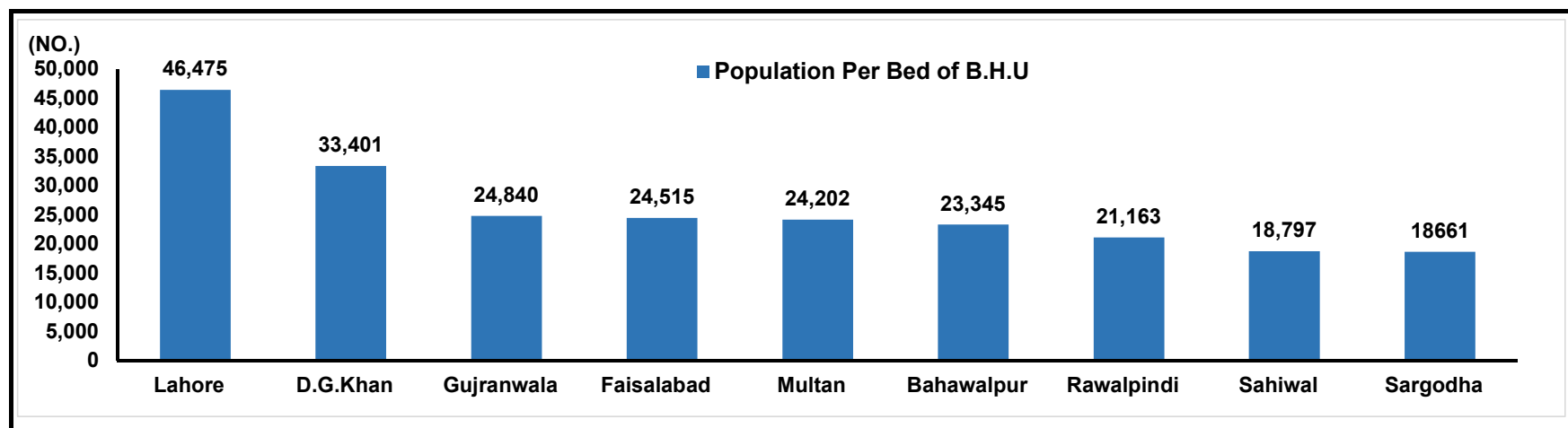


Figure 17 : Population Per Bed of B.H.U by Division, The Punjab: Upto 31-12-2023

Figure 18: Population Per Total Health Facilities by Division, The Punjab: Upto 31-12-2023

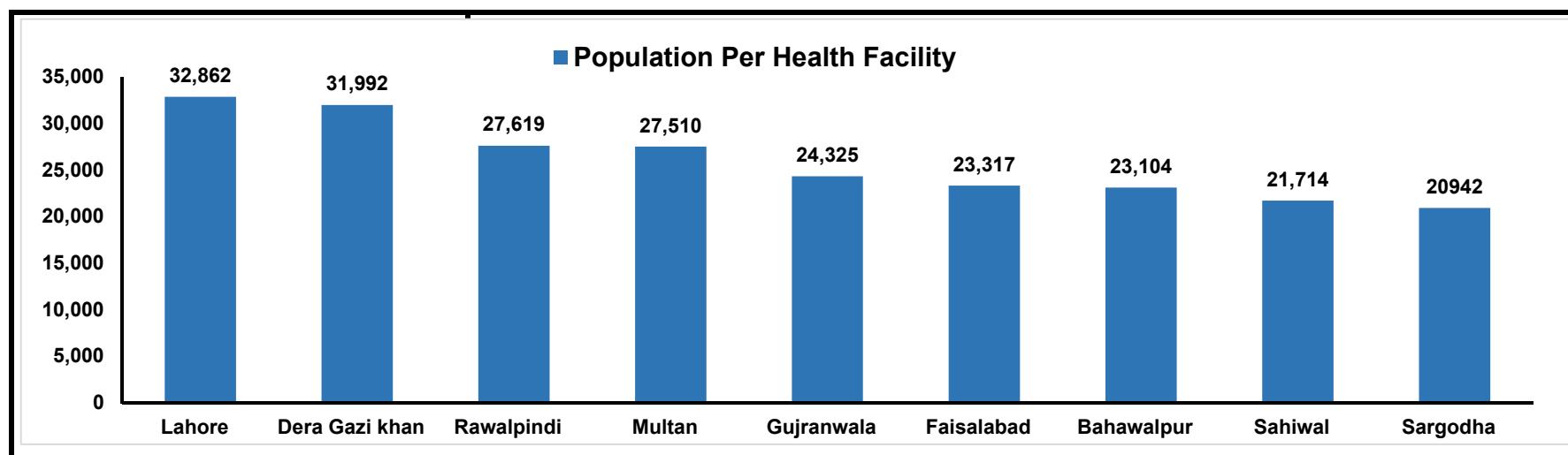
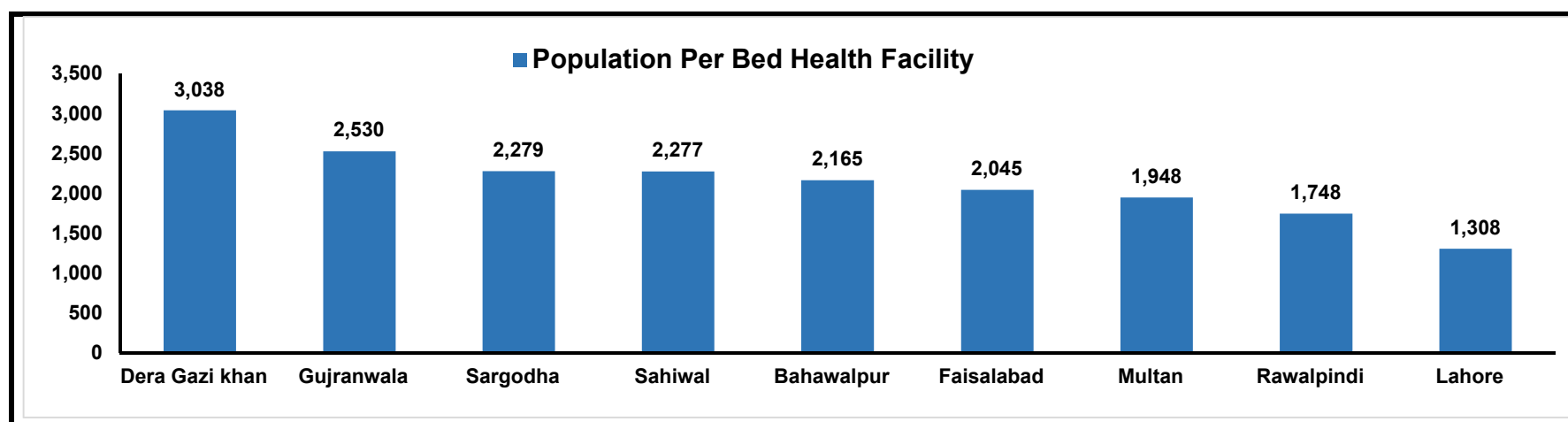


Figure 19: Population Per Bed of Total Facilities by Division, The Punjab: Upto 31-12-2023

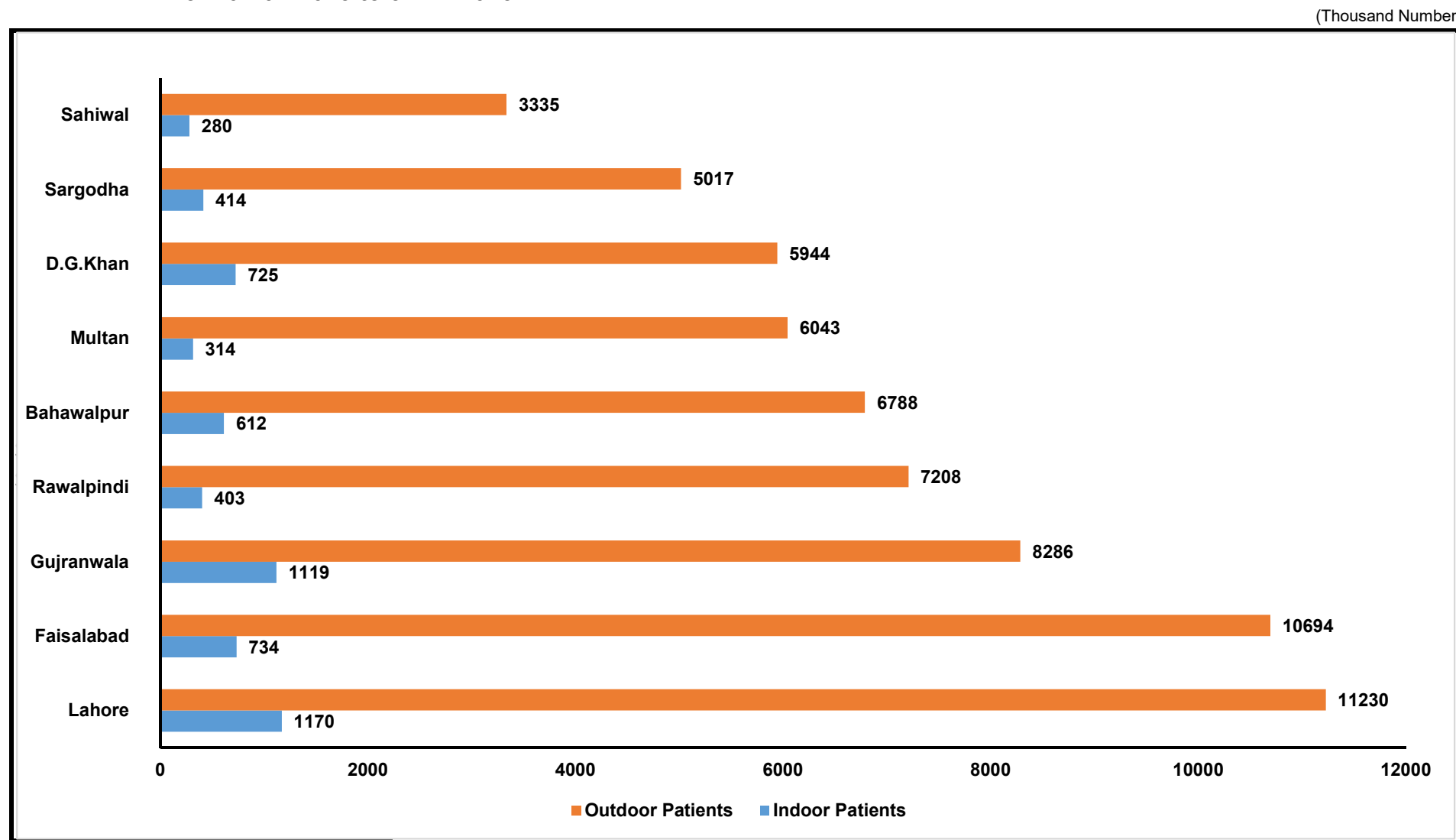

From 01-01-2023 to 31-12-2023**

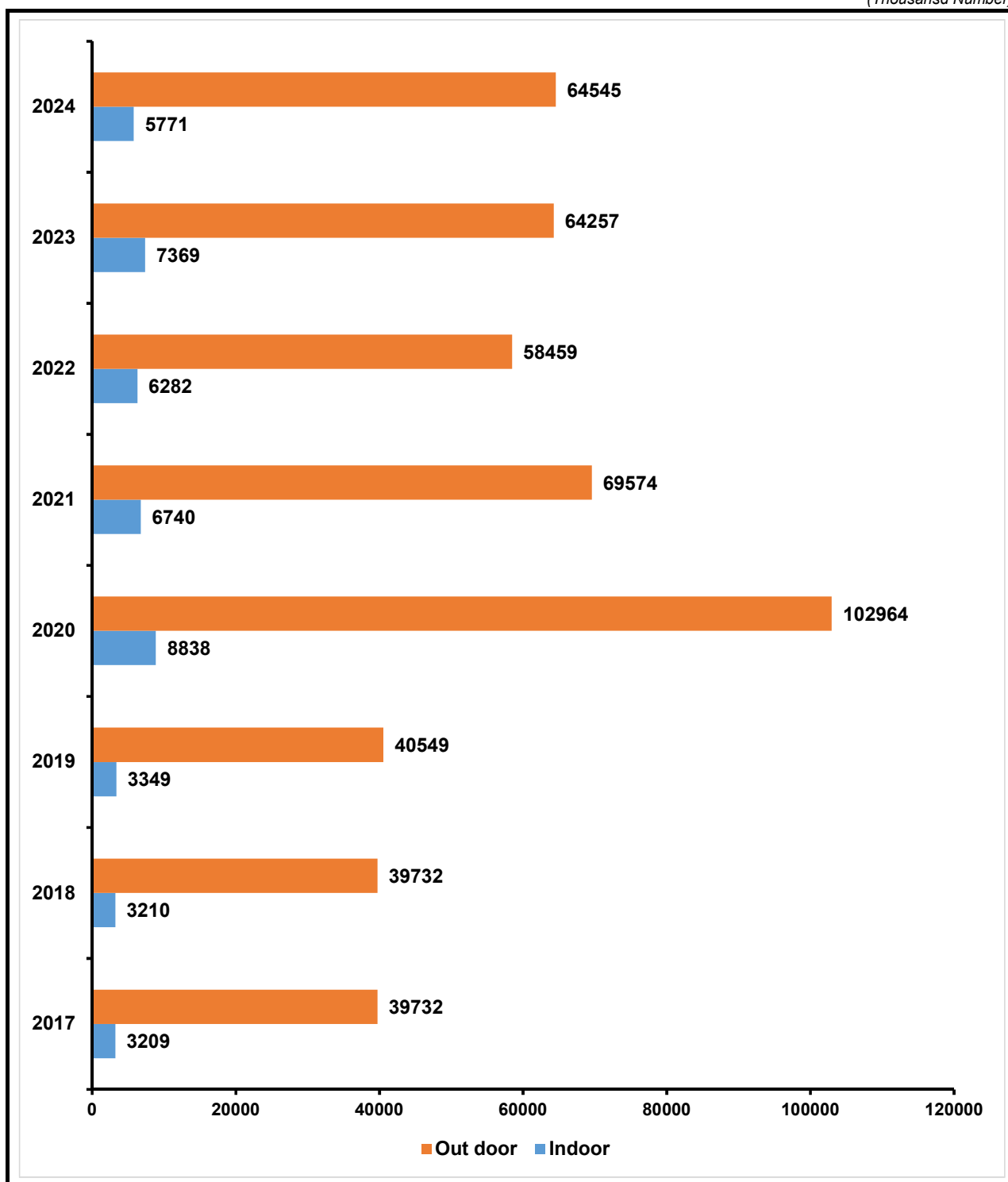

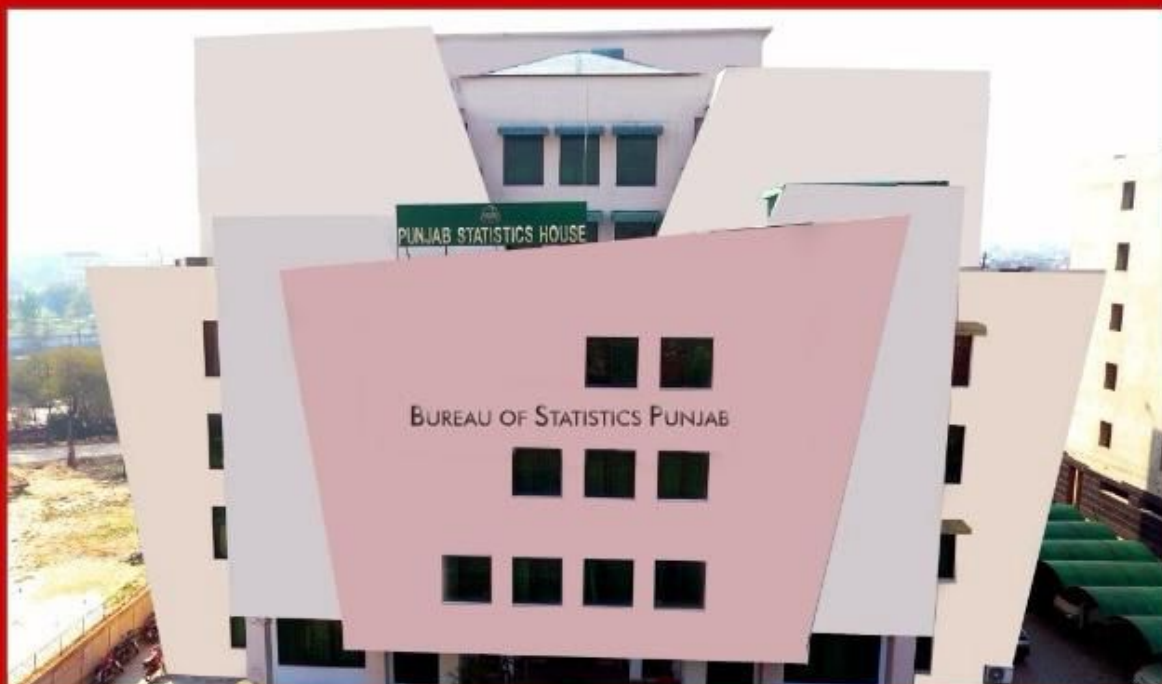
